The section with a thematic focus on 'Skin Cancer' (edited by C. Ulrich) includes papers on any cancers that arise from the skin (basal cell cancer (BCC), squamous cell cancer (SCC) and melanoma). The section 'International Dermatology Outcome Measures' includes papers whose research focus is in alignment with the mission of the non-profit organization 'International Dermatology Outcome Measures' (IDEOM).
